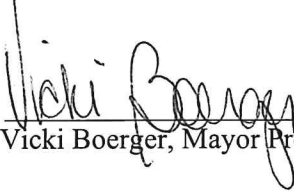

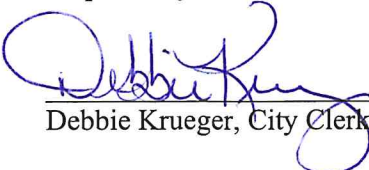

Mrs. Nachazel advised that the Safety Committee is working to improve the markings for crosswalks and is working with the State to improve signals in these areas. Several Council Members expressed interest in the Police Department showing more of a presence in the school areas during the morning and afternoon commutes to slow traffic.
