Program Overview

Certain large events can be challenging to enumerate because of the very large crowd size the event attracts (i.e. Easter Egg Hunt, Independence Day Parade, Tree Lighting, etc.). Compared to last year, some events attracted a larger number of people and others were lower attended (possibly due to weather conditions). Cost is continuing to stay low for residents and for the City. The costs of Recreation to the City for July 1, 2017 – June 30, 2018 was \$20,352.

The City's Recreation Department has gone through several transitional periods over the past year. A variety of new and traditional events were offered to families as well as a wide span of individual age groups. Our programs and events ran smoothly and were only cancelled in the event of bad weather.
