Program Overview

The Fort Mitchell Recreation Department goal is to provide a variety of events to engage City residents and to bring the community together. In the 2018/2019 fiscal year, many new programs were offered (20). The department placed priority on events geared for senior citizens. In the upcoming year, the goal is to focus on events that draw larger crowds (50+). Also, to evaluate how many event participants are Fort Mitchell residents, pre-registration will be required for most City programs.

- July 1, 2018 June 30, 2019 Recreation Expenditures = \$52,950
- July 1, 2017 June 30, 2018 Recreation Expenditures = \$49,232
- July 1, 2016 June 30, 2017 Recreation Expenditures = \$53,562
