Arrowood Viburnum, <i>Viburnum dentatum</i>	White flowers in late spring, very hardy, good for hedges	101	6' to 20' tall
BlackChokeberry, <i>Aronia melanocarpa</i> *	showy white spring flowers, good fall color	381	3' to 6'
Bur Oak, <i>Quercus macrocarpa</i>	large spreading crown, large acorns with fuzzy caps	477	60' to 80'
Elderberry, <i>Sambucus canadensis</i>	shrub, fragrant white flowers in June, red berries in fall, great fall color	33	5' to 12'
Flowering Dogwood, <i>Cornus florida</i> *	understory, white spring flowers, fall red berries, great fall color	111	15' to 30'
Gray Dogwood, <i>Cornus racemosa</i>	shrub, disease and pest resistant, white fruit on red pedicels in early fall	111	4' to 10' tall
Hazelnut, <i>Corylus americana</i>	catkins in spring produce edible nuts in late summer, good fall color	118	10' to 16' tall
Pawpaw, <i>Asimina triloba</i> *	unusual brown bell-shaped flowers in spring, delicious fruit in fall.	13	15' to 30'
Persimmon, <i>Diospyros virginiana</i>	decorative bark pattern, need male and female for fruit	46	35' x up to 60'
Shellbark Hickory, <i>Carya lacinata</i>	oval crown, bark exfoliates in long strips, edible nuts in fall	231	60' to 80' x 40' to 60'
Swamp White Oak, <i>Quercus bicolor</i>	shiny green leaves with white undersides, low maintenance, prefers moisture	477	50' to 60'

Buttonbush, <i>Cephalanthus occidentalis</i> *	ball-shaped, fragrant, white flowers, needs moisture	25	5' to 12' x 4' to 8'
