



Temporary Permit

A temporary permit is required for parked vehicles over 18 feet which can include: certain trailers, recreational vehicles, campers, boats, or similar types of equipment.

Permit must be printed and displayed on vehicle to be visible from the street. Each residence is allowed eighteen 24 hour permits, and two 72 hour permits per year.

Vehicles with blades (example boat motor) must have a coving over the blades.

Other Options to Store

(must get approved and obtain building/zoning permit from PDS, 859-331-8980, before proceeding)

- On paved surface in the rear yard
- Store in enclosed building

SECTION 9.23 REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO PARKING OR STORING OF TRAILERS, MOBILE HOMES, CAMPERS, INOPERABLE VEHICLES, AND OTHER SUCH TYPE EQUIPMENT

C. Outside storage of any trailer, recreational vehicle, camper, boat, or similar type equipment, with a length of not more than eighteen (18) feet, shall be restricted to a paved surface in the rear yard of all lots within the jurisdiction of the legislative body, or in an enclosed building, except as herein provided, and in cases where, due to unique conditions, topographic or other, which do not allow use of the rear yard, the board of adjustment may permit such storage to be
